AST 111 Academic Staff Training

Please note the following:

- (a) Each Course Unit for BSc. TRT and CREB has 4 and 3 contact hours per week [i.e. 60 and 45 contact hours respectively in 15 taught weeks in Semester One].
- (b) The Course delivery will be based on 60% lectures and 40% Field work.
- (c) The one hour Foundation Course (FC) period at ARU from Mondays to Fridays is compulsory for all ARU students.
- (d) It is advisable that the one hour each for the “Curricular and co-curricular activities” and Research/Study/Library/Internet indicated on the Time Table should always be utilised profitably for academic purposes.
- (e) The Library and the Computer Room shall always be open from 09:00 am to 05:00 pm from Mondays to Fridays. On Saturdays, the Library and the Computer Room shall be opened up to Mid-day.

- (f) Depending on the arrangements between the lectures and the students, the double lecture hours after lunch can always be utilised for Field Work. Therefore, a close inspection of the Time Table will be paramount.
- (g) The University shall make arrangements on request to extend [if deemed necessary] the Computer Room and Library hours during the Semester Period.
